





Located within three kilometers of four Provincially Significant Wetlands, this parcel not only safeguards an important connection for wildlife to move and migrate between these wetlands, it also enhances landscape resilience to many anticipated impacts of climate change, including flooding and drought.

The property itself consists of natural cover, with a variety of upland forest and treed swamp, providing excellent habitat for an abundance of wildlife. Found in the area are 24 at-risk species and 16 provincially rare species including cerulean warbler, black ash, Blanding's turtle and eastern foxsnake.

Be a part of this exciting conservation project and help us make tangible gains for conservation. Together, we urgently need to raise \$200,000 to purchase this property and protect it forever.
